The novel event will consist of one board rider and one cycle rider, racing two laps against three other teams, after which board rider and cycle rider will swap places and go for another two laps.

Members are Ed Sumner and Glen Bente, George Webster and A. Milla, Junior Soldate and Alfred Grappo, with Harry Kachadourian and Danny Kachadourian as alternate team. All are Fresnoans.
